NORTH DAKOTA STATE ELECTRICAL BOARD MINUTES SPECIAL MEETING

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2012

The North Dakota State Electrical Board was called to order at 10:22 a.m. at the offices of Smith Bakke Porsborg Schweigert & Armstrong, 122 East Broadway Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. Ben Koppelman motioned and Karen Karls seconded to set up interviews with these four individuals. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board then discussed the interview process. Interviews will be scheduled for March 6, 2012, the day before the next regularly scheduled Board Meeting. The members of the Board will interview the applicants. The interviews will be noticed as a Special Meeting, which will commence at 8:00 a.m., and which will be held at the offices of Smith Bakke Porsborg Schweigert & Armstrong, 122 East Broadway Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.
